
Q1 How would you rate the new "All College" format for convocation?







Room Issues

• It was very difficult to hear the portion that took place in the Student Center. The acoustics and movement made it all very distracting.

• There was no clarity of words in what was spoken to the audience in the student center. The mike system worked very poorly.

• It is super hard to hear in the college center. Please move to a room where we can have better acoustics. Could not hear a lot of what was said as people were talking in the back and the poor acoustics. I think it is a great time to work on assessment, however there needs to be much more time allotted for this portion as we have a large discipline with few FT faculty. Wish we had more time with Lasana Hotep. He was terrific!

• I couldn't hear at the morning sessions. The room is not a good choice for presenting. There was not enough support for the SLO work.

Content

• We need to have safety presentations at every convocation.

• I hoped there would be more training on emergency/active shooter preparedness, but I have heard there is training planned for the fall.

Format
