1. What is "equity" for a Hartnell student?

Activity opened with an online polling app to refresh ideas on equity. The group revisited the four equity statements developed last semester. Two groups formed to refine the definitions with the goal to develop one cohesive statement as the committee's guiding principle. There was much discussion as we looked closely at the words and their meanings. The combined themes include: individuals, fairness, empower, address bias/barriers. The two definitions are as follows:

- a) With an awareness of historical context and through the evaluation of inequities, we commit to provide a student centered design of the college experience at Hartnell to ensure that every student receives what they need in a tailored pathway to successfully achieve their varied educational, career and personal goals.
- b) Through evaluation of structural inequities at Hartnell, we commit to ensure every student has the support, guidance, resources, and experiences to fulfill their educational goals and opportunities.

Committee members will choose which statement to adopt in an online survey.
