Flexible timeline to graduation

- Majority of program participants will get Associates degree with no more than 70 transferable units
- For our 3-year graduation rate, 75% of our active program participants will transfer to a 4-year institution
- 80% of program participants who engage in our program activities will demonstrate a stronger sense of identity
- 80% of program participants will persist 1 academic term to the next academic term


CBEST Workshops




Our Students are SUCCESSFUL

Cohort 1: 76% in 2 years 100% in 3 years


Cohort 2: 84% in 2 years 97% in 3 years (projected)


