### CAMPUS COMMUNITY,

Here is the weekly (MAR 5) update on Measure T Construction Projects:

All projects still remain closed to outside visitors for the protection of the construction workers on site.

#### MAIN CAMPUS

### **BUILDING D AND E / PLAZA AND ELEVATOR:**

Building E - No significant changes from last week - elevator shaft still the focus of the work.

#### NURSING

As noted last week stud framing was pretty much completed this last week with a few areas still to be completed. Soffit framing is on schedule and will continue to be installed through the month of March. Electrical, Plumbing and mechanical continues rough-in of their system through March. The weather barrier (closing in of the exterior shell) began and also continued through mid-March. Exterior painting of portions of exterior steel will be painted next week.

#### BUILDING B 2ND FLOOR

No change in status. Work is pending completion of the nursing building and move of the nursing program into its new home.

#### SERIES B PROJECTS - Main Campus

### Building C Re-roof:

Work continues to progress.

#### Building J and K:

Each building is in the design stage. Building K has scheduled a status meeting with the design/programming committee the second week of March. HGHB (Architect for J) met with their program committee and are continuing to work on the information the committee presented to them.

### **SOUTH CAMPUSES:**

#### SOLEDAD:

The interior is seeing fire and data systems installed through mid-March. The final clean of the building is to be March 8-12. On the exterior landscaping continues to be installed. Completion is anticipated to be mid-March. [SEE PHOTOS]

#### KING CITY:

Solar panel installation resumes next week and is anticipated to be 2 weeks to completion. The ADA area in front of the building has started and is estimated to be a three week project. Final punch list items are being addressed on the interior.

Wall framing/blocking continues through mid-March. Electrical rough-in is following behind framing. Rough-in for Plumbing and Mechanical scheduled to start at the end of next week. [SEE PHOTOS]


