- Data to Enrollment Management Team (4/27)
- Build Workshops (divide students into majors)
- Invite students to Registration Guidance Workshop
 - April 29th-May 15th
 - Counselor/CPT Facilitate
 - 1.5 hours: morning, afternoon, evening, Saturdays
 - 30 students per workshop
 - Approx 40 workshops (in less than 3 weeks)
