

Salinas Valley Promise program at Hartnell College offers a free year of in-state tuition for first-time, full-time college students who have completed high school or adult school in the Salinas Valley regardless of family income.

How is it different from last year?

Salinas Valley Promise Program Model

Program Benefits

- 2 years of **free in-state tuition**, regardless of household income
- A free computer OR support for books
- Participation in a summer leadership institute
- Quarterly professional development workshops with fellow Promise students
- Mentoring by a local professional



- Incentivize full time enrollment
- Decrease cost of attendance
- Increase retention and success
- Decrease time to completion
- Increase completion






Program Outcomes




706 Salinas Valley Promise students

Eligibility Requirements

- Be a graduate of a high school or adult school within the Hartnell Community College District
- First-time college student
- Enroll full-time (at least 12 units or more)
- Submit the FAFSA or the California Dream Act Application
- Participate in the summer leadership institute
- Participate in mentorship and professional development workshops
- Maintain at least a 2.0 semester GPA




Salinas Valley Promise Program Model



Program Activities

- Summer Leadership Institute
 - Resource fair, financial literacy, teambuilding, Hartnell technology
- Professional Development Workshops
 - Networking, personality assessment, emotional intelligence, goal setting
- Mentorship
 - Students matched with an industry mentor for the year

a. Indicate Hartnell College (School Code: 001209) on your application	DUE: March 2, 2020
3. Submit the Salinas Valley Promise Intent Form	
 4. Enroll and continue as a full-time student at Hartnell College during Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 semesters (12 or more units each semester) a. Waitlisted courses do not count towards the 12 units b. Attendance at Panther Prep Day is highly 	April - May 31, 2020 DUE: May 31, 2020
recommended 5. Students notified of admission into Salinas Valley Promise	
6. Sign-up for Summer Leadership Institute (SLI)	May - June 2020
8. Attend Summer Leadership Institute (SLI)	July - August 2020
