

Eligibility Requirements

- First-time college student
- CA resident or qualify for non-resident tuition exemption through AB540/SB68
- Enroll full-time (at least 12 units or more)*
*DSPS accommodation for reduced course load
- Submit the FAFSA or the California Dream Act Application for 2022-2023
- Participation in Student Success Seminar: Math Academy, COU-1, COU-21, or COU-23

Steps: Due by Pledge Registration Deadline April 2022

1. Submit an application for admissions to Hartnell College through [CCCApply](#)
2. Submit the [FAFSA](#) (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) or [California Dream Act Application](#)
 - a. Indicate Hartnell College (School Code: 001209) on your application
3. Submit the [Salinas Valley Promise Program Application](#). Open December 2021.
