SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS

1. Pronto – LTI Communications Platform (remote) To meet RSI (regular substantive interaction) needs. Can be synchronous or asynchronous. Mobile app (iOS & Android) and web-based (Canvas integration). Groups automatically loaded from Canvas, also can be created in app. Can unsubscribe from group that you were added to. Names populated from Canvas; pictures set in Pronto. Name and email address gathered from Canvas, but masked to users. SSO with Canvas, message sent to email app to verify app. Sign-in is persistent on phone, but can explicitly log out. Three roles in Pronto: admin – Pronto back-end, teacher – power over chat, can delete messages posted by anyone; students - can create groups, delete own messages. Messages are tracked in back-end, possible for admin to see deleted messages. Instant translation option, teacher can disable. Insert photos in chat. Create tasks with due dates, can assign a person, or leave it open to claim, see claimed and assigned tasks, mark complete. Insert files from cloud accounts, view all photos and files in group settings. Gif tools feature to increase engagement. Go live to open live video chat, text chats sent during go live added to group feed, can record video as personal (only own video) or group (all participants who shared). 10 people can share video, 400 can view. Recorded video can be replayed and downloaded (mp4). Question whether videos are captioned? Group chat feed can be read out. Canvas app has link to automatically open Pronto app. Web version is nearly identical. In Canvas web page, possible to add Pronto to global navigation. In course, Pronto added to course navigation links. Within Canvas includes screen-sharing. Cost – OEI contract \$2.25/FTES (IPEDS)/year; \$1000 implementation (waived if part of pilot, OEI pays first year subscription for pilot colleges). Quick implementation in Canvas; training for faculty,

Concerns that there is overlap between existing products (cranium café, confer zoom). Provides more access to student clubs for distance students (some clubs are creating Canvas shells). Instant translation is desirable. Pronto collects all interactions in one place, easier to evaluate RSI. Could roll out only to selected faculty for pilot. Yousef likes live streaming feature, not sure if students would use chat, app not that interesting, already have two apps (EllucianGo and Canvas). On the expensive side. It's a better way for students to interact with each other, put them into groups. Useful for group work, students can have chats only with group. Easier to share files than in Canvas. Suggestion to research, talk to other colleges using Pronto, come back as action item at next meeting. Would need data sharing agreement.
