















Q8 Training related to governance activities and participation was effective.











IT staff asked how this new platform differed from software currently in use (Cranium Cafe, Zoom), but faculty appeared defensive. Someone asked what the student thought, student reported that he did not personally like it and did not think his friends would utilize it. Faculty replied with a statement about how that was the one student's opinion. It seemed to me that beause the student's opinion did not align with what faculty were pursuing, the student's opinion was dismissed. Student no longer participated for the rest of the meeting. I was uncomfortable with this interaction.




N/A I have not yet been a part of a decision made as a result of discussion. Sometimes too many rounds of discussion and review.

Q14 I feel that my participation in governance was important and valuable to the College.








Q16 Different opinions and values were respected.


I did not feel differing opinions were disrespected but I do not believe everyone's opinion around the table carries the same weight.


