We have no group membership requirements. However, our goal is to help create "<u>inclusive classroom and campus space[s]</u> for LGBTQ students" and the College community, so sexism, racism, homophobia, transphobia, heterosexism, other hatreds, and other intolerances have no place here.

*Campus Pride definition:

"Ally: An individual whose attitudes and behavior are supportive and affirming of all genders and sexual orientations and who is active in combating homophobia, transphobia and heterosexism, both personally and institutionally."

Ideas for 2022 - Areas of focus (2020)

- Safe Spaces
 Identify and provide directional information to gender neutral restrooms.
- Institutional Language
 Implement protocols for use of pronouns and language for syllabi (Academic Senate/instructional and Counseling faculty).
- Student Engagement Re-establish Pride Club and coordinate key events at the College (Student Life). Key events include - June - Pride Month, october - LGBTQ+ History Month, October 11 - National Coming Out Day.
- Online Presence Create a web presence for resources and information for students.
 Provide lists of key contacts at Hartnell and resources in Monterey County, (Equity Programs).
- Data Improve data collection, analysis and tracking.
