At Hartnell College, a student's academic performance is measured by two main factors.

1. GPA - Grade Point Average 2.0
2. Units Completed \div Units Attempted

A student who has enrolled in 12 units and does not maintain at least a 2.0 GPA **AND** complete at least 50% of their attempted coursework will be placed on **academic and/or progress probation.**



PROGRESS PROBATION

The number of units are recorded of "W" , "I" , "NP", "NC" reaches or exceeds fifty-percent (50%) of all units attempted.
(page 42 catalog)

What is your completion rate?

SOLVE: $\#Units\ Completed / \#Units\ Attempted = \% \text{ Progress}$

EX: $30/79 = .37\%$

REMOVAL OF PROGRESS PROBATION

When students units completed exceeds 50% of all attempted units



ACADEMIC PROBATION

Students cumulative GPA fall below a 2.0 in all units graded



REMOVAL OF ACADEMIC PROBATION

Level 1 Academic/Progress Probation (A1/P1)

Level 2 Academic/Progress Probation (A2/P2)

Students placed in A1/P1 or A2/P2 probation must complete the PAWS probation workshops in order to register for classes. Removal of academic probation happens when the student's cumulative GPA becomes 2.0 or higher



NOTE: Completion of A1/P1 and/or A2/P2 workshops will clear hold in 24 hrs.

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ACADEMIC COUNSELING

Probation students are provided with academic counseling services to ensure support of academic goals and getting ontrack to academic improvement.

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DISQUALIFICATION/DISMISSAL

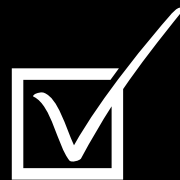
A student shall be dismissed for two semesters (not including summer session) if during each of the three consecutive semesters the student's performance falls under one or the combination of the following two conditions:

1. GPA - Grade Point Average falls below a 2.0
2. Units Completed \div Units Attempted falls below 50%

Academic/Progress Reinstatement Petition

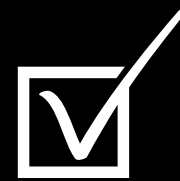


DISMISSAL/REINSTATEMENT PETITION PROCESS



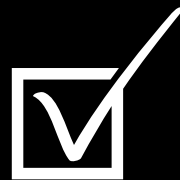
